a. B.F.17J008 Library Terrace

Nigel Watkins – SGA president – Library is the heart of campus. Quad is not used as much as we would like it. There is a new library dean and they are investing a lot of money into the first floor. This includes new walkways, terrace, and a brick campaign. Investment to the infrastructure of the building.

- The original project was a walkway from the dorms to the Engineering Building, costing \$31,546.50.
- Brick campaign – from the Alumni Association. The brick may cost \$40-\$50. This is still in discussion.
- We project this to be completed by end of Spring 2018.
- Sooner we get the support from students, the sooner it will be completed.
- President Nicklow has committed to roughly \$31,500. He is doubling SGA's amount and adding additional funds to this project.
- Paige- (Where is he getting the funds? What bill?) Unsure.
- (Does Nicklow's funds go under Business Affairs?) Yes. Business Affairs will handle.
- (Will SGA's name be on this project?) Yes. They will have a plaque.
- Aucoin – Senator – Tabling the voting of the bill until the 27<sup>th</sup>. If not completed by then, the funds will be allocated back into the account.
