A Bill

This is a bill to allocate \$450.00 from the Senate Operating Account to assist UNO Club Soccer on their 2017 campaign which is currently underway, with preseason training kicking off on August 1st. Whereas, the UNO Club Soccer team has operated in the past, it was registered again with the Office of Student Involvement and Leadership in August of 2016.

- II. ALL UNUSED FUNDS SHALL REVERT BACK TO THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION AT THE END OF THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR.

IV. SOCCER CLUB SHALL REPORT BACK TO THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION WITHIN 30 DAYS UPON COMPLETION OF THE EVENT.
